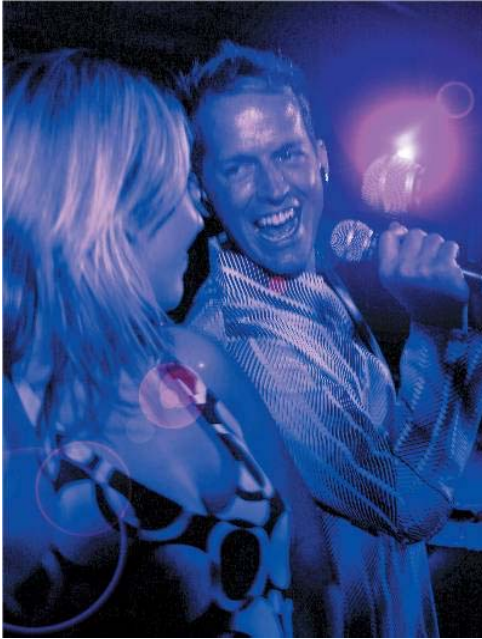


Caprice
