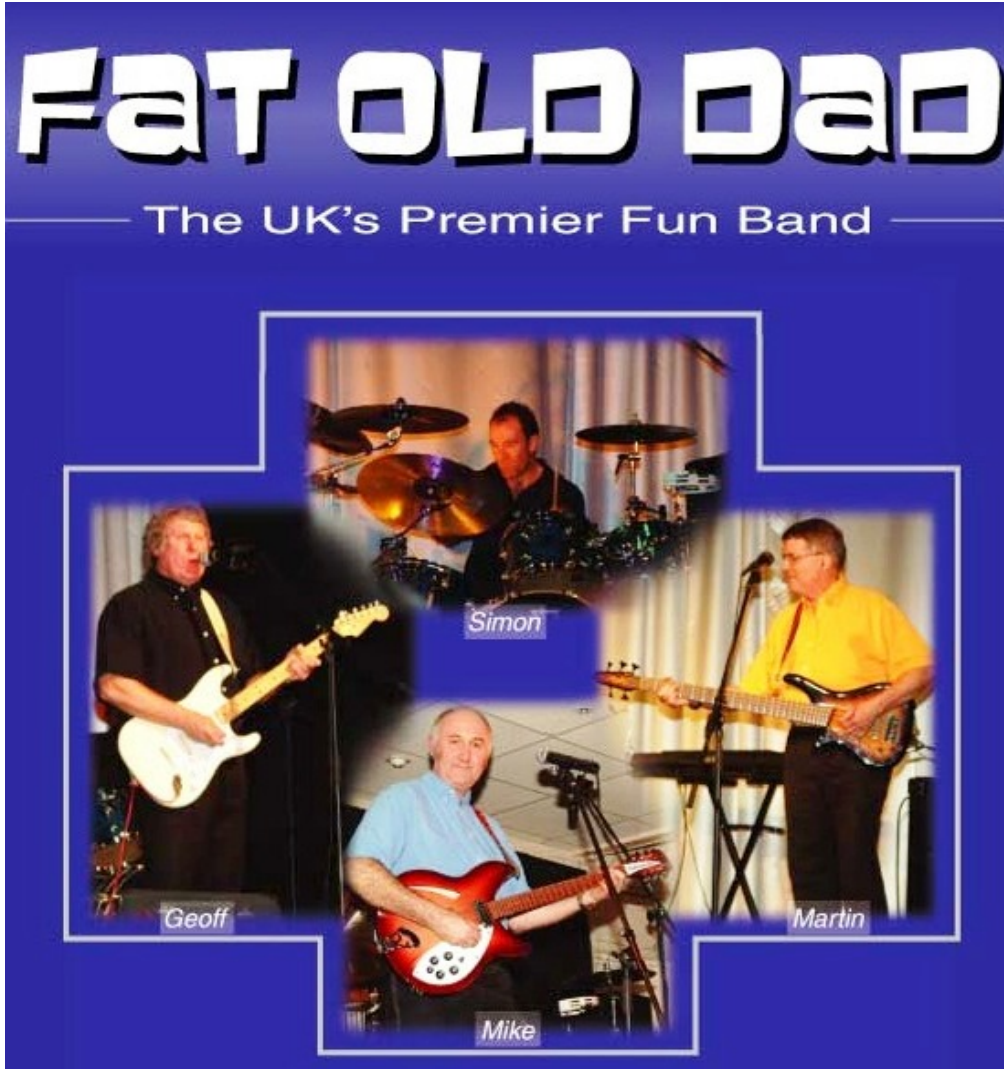


## ***Fat Old Dad***

They have also appeared at the world famous Highbury Stadium the home of Arsenal Football Club and been on BBC Radio.
